Initially organized by the [Hampton Fire Department](#) as a fundraiser for two of their own firefighters, the Department has since turned the event into an annual fundraiser for [Code 3 for a Cure \(C3FAC\)](#) to assist fellow firefighters across America who are suffering with occupational cancer. C3FAC founders and other team members will be in attendance, and some of the firefighters participating will wear their fire gear as a symbol of support for all firefighters who are battling occupational cancer.
